Registered as an Ontario Non-Profit Corporation, ACCESS has helped children at multiple schools in the Dominican Republic, Colombia, Honduras, and more by providing them with school uniforms, shoes, and necessary supplies since March 2006. ACCESS has also supported needs such as classroom equipment, teaching assistants, school renovations, and transportation. ACCESS also promotes Fair Trade products such as chocolate and sugar, supporting foreign workers.

Student-run, the inspiration behind this organization came from a high school trip to the Dominican Republic, where Canadian students were exposed to the extreme poverty that the people of this beautiful country face.

Speaking at schools and conferences and spreading the word about poverty in the developing world is the current mission of ACCESS, as the organization continues to expand, raising funds and involving today's youth.
